Visits include:

- **Genesis Youth Trust** Genesis Youth Trust combines youth work, social work, mentoring, counselling, family therapy, and whänau programmes to promote positive lifestyle changes to at risk youth and their families. As a result of a social impact bond launched in 2017, around 1000 at risk young people from South Auckland stand to benefit from a 6-year programme.
- **Ooooby** we will visit the warehouse of Ooooby, a social enterprise that delivers local organic food to households. Ooooby is now established in NZ, Australia and the US. Impact investing has played and is continuing to play a role in helping scale Ooooby's operations and aspirations.
- Tamaki Regeneration Company (TRC) TRC is the largest urban renewal project in New Zealand. We will visit a number of projects where impact investment is playing a role to deliver positive community outcomes including affordable housing and healthcare.
